- **The use of profane or abusive language will not be allowed inside or on the grounds, during activities, or on field trips**
- **Will not engage or attempt to engage in or knowingly consent to any form of dishonesty, to include deviation from the truth.**

- **Will show respect for their peers and all adults.**
- **Will not violate municipal ordinances, state and federal laws.**
- **Will not wear gang related attire or clothing deemed inappropriate by KCKPD personnel.**
- **Will show good sportsmanship and teamwork during all activities.**
- **Will be responsible for their own actions, conduct and self-discipline.**
- **Fighting will not be tolerated inside or on the grounds, while attending sponsored activities, events and/or while attending field trips.**
- **All applicants are required to bring any incidents involving violations of the Rules of Conduct to the attention of an officer.**
- **All applicants will bring any difficulties they may have in maintaining these rules of conduct to the attention of an officer.**
- **The use of tobacco products is strictly prohibited inside the building's, during activities, or on field trips.**
